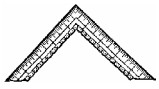

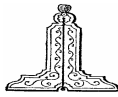


FREEDOM DAYS PARADE

MASONIC EDUCATION

Summer History Classes from UCLA

Across countries and centuries, Freemasonry has shaped governments and societies. But until recently, only limited academic research and coursework was devoted to the subject.

That changed in 2008, when the Grand Lodge of California initiated an important partnership with the University of California, Los Angeles. Dr. Margaret C. Jacob, one of the world's foremost Masonic Scholars, lead the development of two courses on the history of Freemasonry, debuting this spring at UCLA.

This summer, Grand Lodge and UCLA are offering the opportunity for all Masons (MM, FC & EA) to participate in accelerated versions of these courses.

The courses will explore Freemasonry's

- Impact on European and American history from the Enlightenment through today
- Role in the early development of modern thought, culture and politics
- Contributions to the evolution of individual rights and democratic societies


Course details

- Meet once a week for three consecutive weeks, 6:30 to 10:00 p.m.
- Participants are expected to read select material from primary and secondary sources
- Participate in lectures and discussions

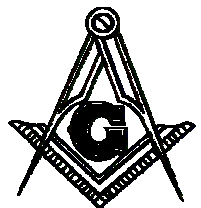
