Please attend the Stated Meeting in December.

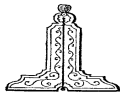

Past reports show that 1999 was the best year for 381, when with 277 members, 77% gave a total of \$10,706.86 in contributions.

This year's report is not the poorest year for the lodge, but it is close. In 2002-03 with 229 members only 59 or 17.93% made donations of \$3,323.68 for an average per contributor of \$14.51.
